



Safety Requirements at Worksites

Safety is of utmost importance to DeLeers Construction. Keeping our employees, trade partners, and visitors safe is a high priority. To maintain a safe work environment, we have put into place the following safety requirements for visitors to our work sites.

1. When arriving on site, all visitors must sign in on the visitor log and be issued their PPE located in the job trailer. When leaving the site, visitors must sign out on the visitor log and return the PPE.
2. All visitors must be escorted by a DeLeers employee at all times.
3. All visitors must wear proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) while on-site. An ANSI approved hard hat, high visibility vest or shirt, safety glasses, and closed toed construction grade shoes (no high heels) are to be worn at all times. Hearing protection can be worn as appropriate. Please see the site Superintendent to be issued your PPE.
4. Be aware of your surroundings and exercise caution at all times. This is an active job site. Always look for potential hazards surrounding you which may also be above you:
 - a. Watch for and step over/around trip hazards (nails, cords, debris, etc.)
 - b. Watch your footing on uneven ground
 - c. Look up and be aware of potential hazards above you.
 - d. Never walk beneath a suspended load
 - e. Watch for and avoid moving equipment (ex. forklift, trucks, lifts, etc.)
 - f. Listen for possible warnings or alerts
 - g. Do not cross barricades or cones without approval
 - h. Observe any posted warning signs
 - i. Do not touch stray wires, cables etc.
5. No visitors under the age of 18.
6. No smoking or use of tobacco products or vaping devices.
7. Visitors must not be under the influence of or in possession of alcohol or prohibited substances.
8. Taking photos or videos must be approved by DeLeers.
9. No food allowed on site.
10. No animals are allowed on site unless they are registered service animals.
11. No handling of any tools or construction equipment.
12. Do not climb ladders or scaffolding.

13. Do not leave personal items on the construction site, DeLeers is not responsible for lost or stolen personal items.
14. Loud music, headsets, or Bluetooth devices that could obstruct the ability for those on site to communicate effectively and safely is prohibited. Volumes that interfere with anyone's ability to hear emergency notifications are prohibited. Personal music devices with headphones are prohibited.
15. Phones may only be used in spaces deemed safe to do so.
16. Internal site speed limit is less than 5 miles per hour.
17. If an accident, injury, dangerous act, theft or property damage occurs report this to the DeLeers site Superintendent immediately.
18. During a fire or other emergency, evacuate the site immediately.
19. For fire or medical emergencies, call 911.
